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PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION INFORMATION

In order to be certain you have the correct prescription medication and that you have enough of your prescription medication at all times you may help in the following ways:

1. Bring your prescription and nonprescription medication bottles with you to your office visit. This is particularly important if you are seeing us as a new patient. We appreciate your help in knowing your prescription medication names, strength, and the amount needed at the time of your visit.
2. When the nurse checks you in, please give her a list of your prescription medications that need to be refilled and remind us whether you receive your prescriptions in 30 day or 90 day supplies so that we can make sure that they are written accordingly.
3. Read the information you are given regarding prescription medications carefully. All dosages and instructions are given to you at the time you leave the office. Please read our information sheets before reading any information sheets from your pharmacy or pharmacists. It is very important sure that many of the medications we use are not FDA approved specifically for migraine, cluster headache or other headache types.
4. Please recognize that many insurance companies will not pay for certain prescription medications. We always choose prescription medications based on what we feel is best for your individual patient care. However, insurance companies do not always agree. If your prescription medication is not approved by your insurance company we will attempt to obtain prior approval for the particular medicine or will offer an alternative.
5. If a prior approval is required by your insurance company please allow up to 2 weeks for processing the prior approval.
6. Prescriptions for narcotic medication will not be mailed to the patient. These must be picked up in person from our office. If your narcotic prescriptions or narcotic medication is lost or stolen we cannot replace it except at an office visit.
7. We refill all prescriptions at the time of office visits only. Please determine which prescriptions require refill prior to your office visit and bring this information with you to the office visit so that timely refills are accomplished.
